- Refined Figma Dev Mode handoff workflows and surfaced CSS variables in design files to improve implementation consistency across shared design system workflows.
- Remediated 30+ accessibility defects across modal, navigation, form, disclosure patterns (WCAG-aligned keyboard/focus/ARIA/screen readers) with published migration guidance; treated accessible defaults as a hard requirement on net-new primitives.
- Architected Podium's motion subsystem and frontend architecture for reusable motion tokens, utility CSS, interactive docs, and prefers-reduced-motion layering.
- Supported adoption during the EDS→Podium migration across multiple product squads through Slack triage, office hours, rollout coaching, and migration resources.
- Built Podium's first AI-consumable tooling, an MCP Server (Python → TypeScript) serving design tokens, component APIs, and system context directly to engineers and AI agents and pioneered design-language-as-code as a Markdown-native knowledge layer.
